1 Name

This instrument is the *Public Service (Subsection 24(1)—OPC Non-SES Employees) Amendment Determination 2023*.

2 Commencement

This instrument commences on the day after it is made.

3 Authority

This determination is made under subsection 24(1) of the *Public Service Act 1999*.

4 Schedules

Each instrument that is specified in a Schedule to this instrument is amended or repealed as set out in the applicable items in the Schedule concerned, and any other item in a Schedule to this instrument has effect according to its terms.

Schedule 1—Amendments

Public Service (Subsection 24(1)—OPC Non-SES Employees) Determination 2021

1 Section 9

Repeal the section, substitute:

9 Second annual adjustment in salary and allowances

- (1) Employees' salaries are increased by 3%, with effect from 12 May 2023.
Note: This 3% increase in salaries gives effect to the *Public Sector Interim Workplace Arrangements 2022*, which apply to remuneration adjustments scheduled to occur between 1 September 2022 and 31 August 2023.
- (2) The increase is to be calculated based on the salary immediately before the increase.
- (3) The following allowances are increased by the same percentage as salaries, with effect from 12 May 2023:
 - (a) first aid certificate allowance;
 - (b) overtime meal allowance.
- (4) Each increase of an allowance is to be calculated based on the allowance immediately before the increase under subsection (3).
- (5) Schedule 1 has effect.

3 Subsection 10(1) (note)

Repeal the note, substitute:

Note: This existing scheduled adjustment remains in place because the period covered by the *Public Sector Interim Workplace Arrangements 2022* ends on 31 August 2023. As at March 2023, no other remuneration adjustment for 12 May 2024 has been decided or agreed.
